Dear CT Juniors Athletes and Families,

As we continue to monitor the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), our first priority remains the health, safety and security of our athletes, guests and staff. The Connecticut Sports Center and Connecticut Juniors Volleyball has been working diligently to mitigate risk by disinfecting public surfaces, including door handles, counter tops, railings, tables, chairs, gym equipment and restrooms. Volleyballs and basketballs are being disinfecting prior to each use. Our recently installed state of the art HVAC system has been constantly running while the building is in use, bringing in fresh outside air, replacing the air inside the building multiple times per hour. That being said, we feel that these measures are still not enough to insure the safety and well being of our CT Juniors family, and after much deliberation have decided to **postpone the final 2 meetings of the State and Developmental Programs. This includes practice this Sunday, March 15th and the final tournaments on March 22nd (for the State Program) and March 29th (for the Developmental Program).**

Over the past 30 years the Connecticut Juniors has always tried to err on the side of caution when it comes to the safety of our participants. At the recommendation of the Connecticut CDC and the governor we hope our action will increase social distancing by limiting exposure to the more than 500 players from over 75 different towns who participate in CT Juniors. As in the past, we will continue to be proactive instead of reactive.

Moving forward, we will continue to provide updates as new information emerges on COVID-19 and its impact on the Connecticut Sports Center and Connecticut Juniors Volleyball. **These dates WILL be made up sometime this spring or early summer.**

I thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate these unprecedented times, particularly as the situation continues to evolve.
